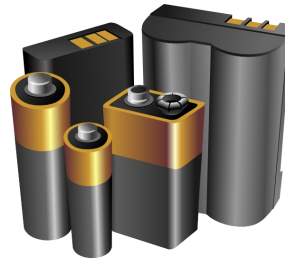
## Are you brave enough for Zoolab!
